- Make better water management decisions

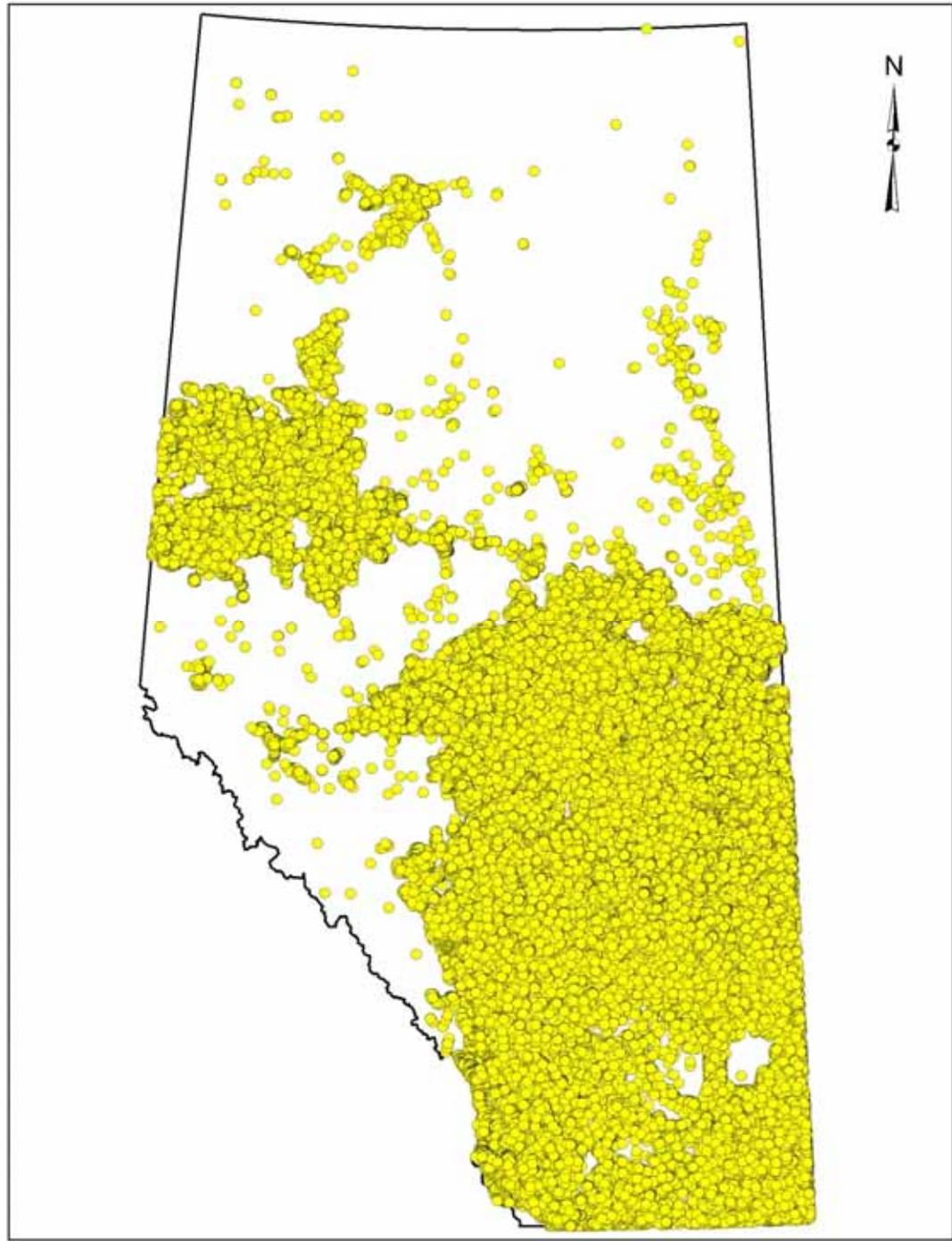
Water Use Reporting

- Reporting methods under Water Act licences:
 - Paper reporting
 - Record, retain and report as requested
 - No reporting condition
- New reporting method
 - Standardized units (volume, rate, etc)
 - Provide easy access to data for reporting and analyzing

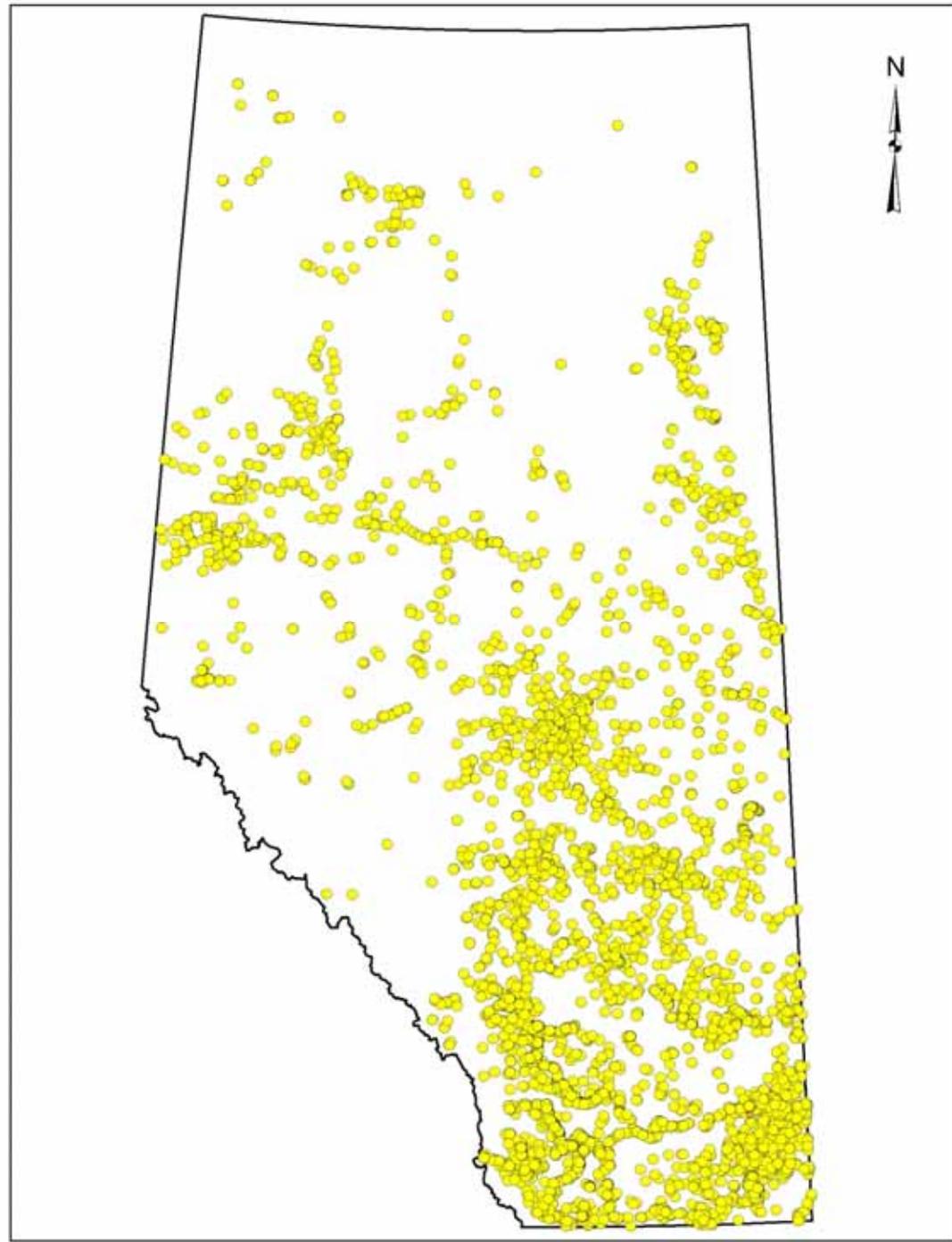
Implementation

- 2006 started with a few large users in each basin
 - 2005 is the baseline year
- Development of guides and video for a wider distribution of the water use reporting system
